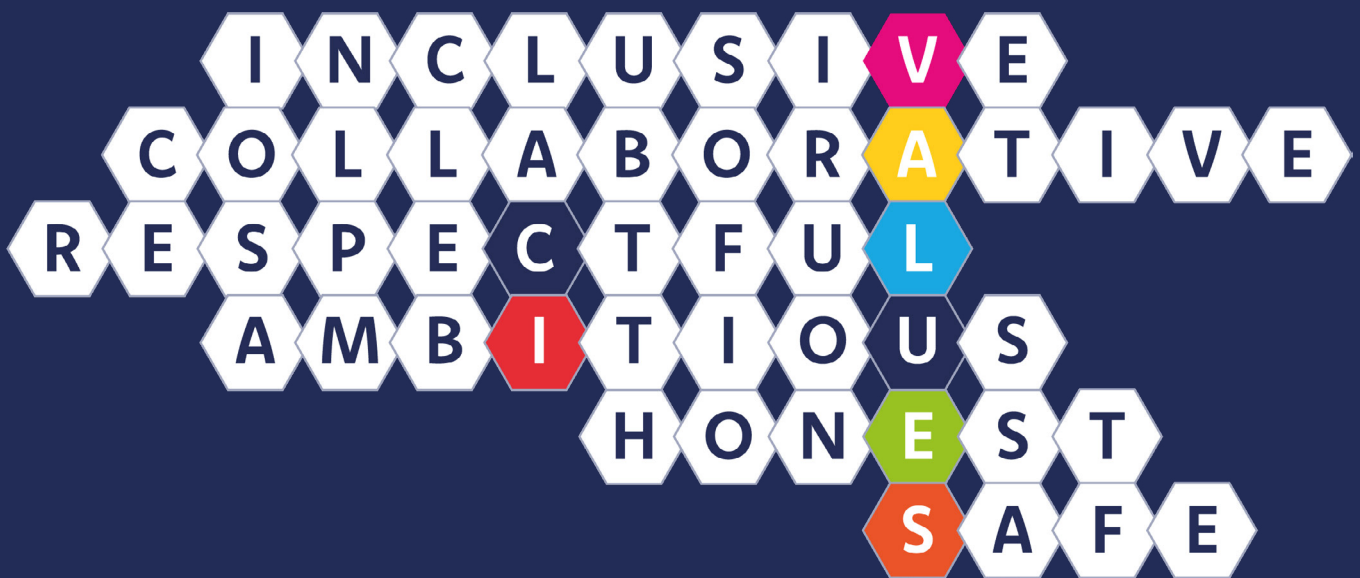

Colchester Institute has been part of the community since 1885, when the Albert School of Art and Design first opened on Colchester High Street. Over the years, it has grown and developed, moving to North Hill by 1912, and later, in 1954, opening the first buildings of the North-East Essex Technical College and School of Art at Sheepen Road. A key milestone came in 1976 when the college merged with St Osyth College of Education to form Colchester Institute, operating campuses in Colchester and Clacton. Following its merger with Braintree College in 2010, Colchester Institute now proudly operates two campuses in Colchester and Braintree.

More than just an educational institution, Colchester Institute is committed to inspiring and empowering students, changing lives and futures while nurturing the next generation of skilled professionals across a variety of practical industries. Since 1965, we have offered higher education courses, with our degree programmes now validated by the University of East Anglia. In 2016, we earned the designation 'University Centre Colchester,' reflecting over 50 years of excellence and our strong focus on employer-led learning.

Our commitment to the community is reflected in our close partnerships with local businesses, which help us address skills gaps and contribute to local economic growth. We work hand in hand with employers to ensure that our students gain real-world experience and are well prepared for work. This friendly, supportive induction is designed to help you settle in, connect with colleagues, and get comfortable with the Colchester Institute way of working. 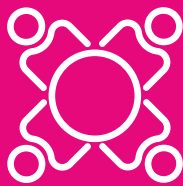

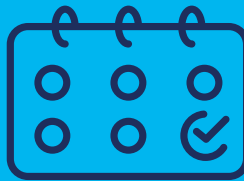

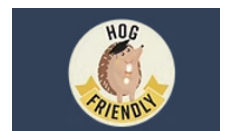
