## How can a Chartered Manager Degree apprentice benefit my business?

A Chartered Manager is someone who can take responsibility for long-term organisational success, managing people, projects, operations or services.

This degree apprenticeship will benefit employers looking to progress the expertise of professionals with the capability of managing complex scenarios at a strategic and/or operational level.

## Who is the Chartered Manager Degree apprenticeship for?

This apprenticeship is ideal for job roles including Manager; Senior Manager; Head of Department; Operations Manager, or anyone with significant management responsibilities.

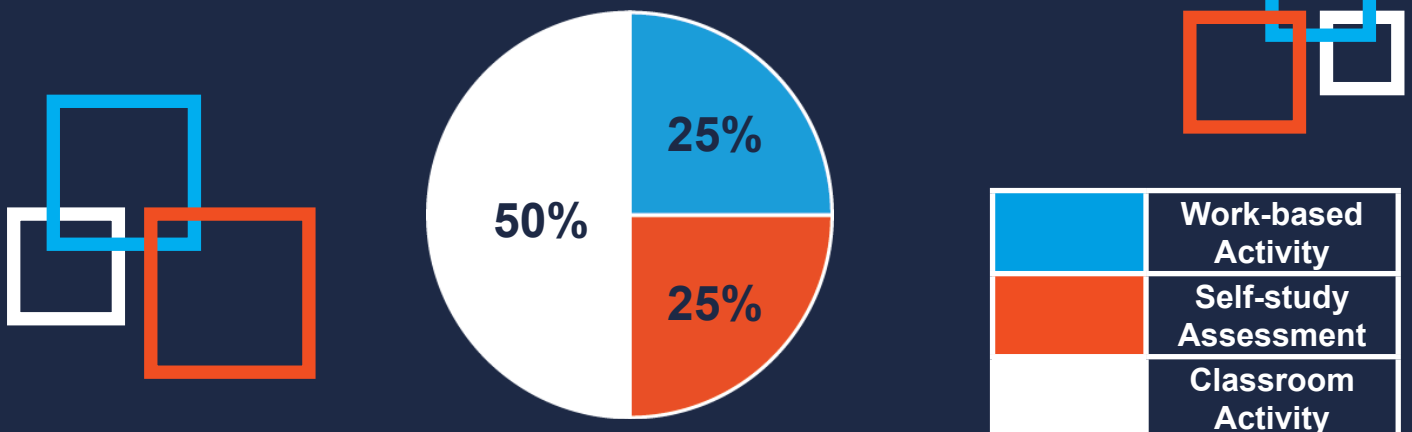
## What will it cost the business to take on an apprentice?

**Levy-paying employers** in England can use funds in their Apprenticeship Service Account to fund apprenticeship training costs.

**Non-levy paying employers:** The government will fund between 95% - 100%\* of the cost of training an apprentice.

\*This depends on how many people are employed within the company, the age of the apprentice and also if they have been in care or have a Local Authority Education, Health and Care Plan

## Entry Requirements

University Centre Colchester will agree the selection criteria with individual employers, but this is likely to include A levels; and/or other relevant qualifications; Level 2 English, Maths and ICT, with relevant experience.

## End Point Assessment

The apprentice will complete assessments both during the programme and at the end. Apprentices will be required to pass the degree, meet Chartered Management criteria, produce a portfolio of work-based learning, and complete a final synoptic assessment.
