Questions – the answers to these may change in line with Government guidelines surrounding COVID-19

- **Who will be my personal tutor?**

You will be taught by a small team of staff however either Jan. Hayley Karl, or Stu will be your personal tutor. This will vary to your timetable. You're welcome to approach any staff member that you feel comfortable talking to.

- **Can I have my mobile phone/electrical devices onsite?**

You are welcome to bring in your devices but it is your responsibility to look after it. Mobile phones are to be switched off or left on silent during sessions. You may use your mobile phone during some sessions but you will be guided by the tutor delivering the session.

- **What support will I get ?**

- Whilst at college you will be supported by Tutors, Learning Support, Student Services and Job Coaches

- **How many people will be in my group?**

Usually group sizes are between 10 to 15

- **Is there a uniform?**

No, you can wear whatever you feel comfortable in as long as it is appropriate for a college environment. All hoods and hats must be removed during sessions.

- **Will I need an ID badge?**

When you enrol you will be issued with a photo ID badge. You will need this for access to site, use of photocopiers and for payment of food in the canteen
