- Access to HE Diploma (Social Work and Related Professions)
- Access to HE Diploma (Maths and Science)
- Access to HE Diploma (Humanities)

All diplomas include core subjects such as Academic Writing and Study Skills. Each diploma then has a mandatory subject (e.g. for health professions it is human biology) and another specialist subject.

We also have Student Welfare who give advice on health, finance and can refer to counselling support.


