


Stepping Up a pathway to success for young ESOL learners

• What is Stepping Up?

- Stepping Up is full time course for students whose first language is not English.
- Whilst the main focus is English (ESOL), students also study maths, ICT and personal and social development.
- Students also increase their understanding of the world of work and take part in work experience.



What you will learn

- You will work towards:
- ESOL qualifications (Entry level or Level 1) in Speaking and Listening, Reading and Writing
- A maths qualification

You will also study: Information and Computer Technology (ICT) Personal and Social Development



You will also have: Group tutorials Individual tutorials Work Experience Extra curricular activities


