

- Adult Care Worker (ACW) in Adult Care– Level 2
  - Lead Adult Care Worker (LAC) in Adult Care – Level 3
  - Lead Practitioner in Adult Care – Level 4
  - Leader in Adult Care – Level 5
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- All learners will need to have completed the Care Certificate before the end of the course for level 2 & 3.

# English and Maths

- All learners will require maths and English GCSE grade D/3 or Functional Skills level 1 for ACW
- All learners will require maths & English GCSE grade C/4 or Functional Skills level 2 for LAC and above
- Learners who have PROXY will not do these & their assessor will continue to build on these with them.



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# Learning and 20% off the job

- Sessions will be planned around the learner
- 20% off the job is the equivalent of 1 hour per day the learner works
- Sessions are via Zoom and learner can use their phone/tablet/computer.
- Sessions can be each week, fortnightly or monthly and is dependent on learner and company.
- The college uses an e-portfolio system
- Evidence gathered will include knowledge questions/ assignments/ Reflective accounts/ observations/ witness statements/work products.



# End Point Assessment –EPA for ACW or LAC

Once the learner completes their standard/diploma/maths/ English/ Care Certificate they will enter EPA

They are given 3 months approximately to prepare for this

EPA involves – multiple choice Evolve test (60 questions in 90 mins) and Professional Discussion (based on self-assessment document) for 45 mins.

Learner can achieve a Pass, Merit or Distinction



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# Health and Social Care

- Once the standard/diploma and English/ maths (if required) are completed learner will enter EPA.
- EPA will last approximately 3 months as the learner prepares for an observation and professional discussion.
- EPA will be over two days
- Learner can Fail, Pass or gain a Distinction
