#### **BEFORE THE CEREMONY**

- 1. Please register at the Town Hall via the Main (High Street) entrance by **2.15pm**. A member of the Marketing team will sign you in. As you are required to wear a gown you will be directed to the Council Chamber. Refreshments will be served in the North Committee Room on the first floor.
- 2. The Moot Hall will open for seating at approximately **2.30pm** and all graduands and their guests will be seated by **2.45pm**.
- **3.** As a member of the Academic Procession you will be asked to assemble in the Mayor's Suite at **2:55pm**. A member of the marketing team will ensure that you are in the correct order and take you to the entrance of the Moot Hall.
- **4.** A safety announcement will be made.
- **5.** At **3pm** the Academic Procession will enter, heralded by a fanfare.

### THE CEREMONY

- **6.** Once the Academic Procession is seated on stage, Kevin Prince will open the ceremony. He will use the left lectern (left for those seated on stage) and welcome visitors and request that they be seated. He will then identify the members of the Academic Procession, followed by welcoming all the graduands and their guests, distinguished quests and staff.
- 7. Kevin Prince will deliver his welcome speech.
- **8.** Kevin Prince will begin the award of honorary degree by inviting Professor Neil James to stand at the right lectern (right for those seated on stage) to read the Senate's authority.
- **9.** Professor Neil James will invite Maeve Borges to stand at the left lectern (left for those seated on stage) to read Adrian Pritchard's oration. Professor Neil James will take his seat.
- **10.** At the conclusion of Adrian Pritchard's oration Maeve Borges will gesture for both Adrian Pritchard and Professor Neil James to stand and shake hands.
- 11. Adrian Pritchard will address the congregation.
- 12. Kevin Prince will ask Nils Franke to stand at the left lectern (left for those seated on stage) to read the formal statement of authority. Nils Franke will then invite David Briggs to stand at the right lectern (right for those seated on stage).

- **13.** David Briggs will read the University of Essex conferral words, before stepping back to his seat, but remaining standing.
  - "I CONFER OR GRANT ON ALL ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES PRESENTED AT THIS CEREMONY IN PERSON OR IN ABSENTIA THE DEGREES, DIPLOMAS AND CERTIFICATES TO WHICH THEY ARE ENTITLED."
- 14. Nils Franke will invite Professor Neil James to stand at the right lectern (right for those seated on stage).
- **15.** Professor Neil James will read the University of East Anglia conferral words, before stepping back to his seat, but remaining standing
  - "BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF EAST ANGLIA I CONFER ON THESE CANDIDATES, AND THOSE IN ABSENTIA, THE AWARD FOR WHICH THEY HAVE QUALIFIED."
- **16.** Kevin Prince will introduce George Kieffer. Kevin Prince will deliver a short speech and then invite George Kieffer to present the awards. George Kieffer will move in front of the left lectern (left for those seated on stage) to begin the presentation of certificates to Graduands and to shake each Graduand's hand.
- 17. Kevin Prince will introduce Mick Stubbs, who will move from his seat to the right lectern (right for those seated on stage) to start the presentation of the awards for the School of Visual and Performing Arts. Mick Stubbs will then call the relevant Course Leader, who will proceed to the bottom of the downward flight of stairs on the left side of the stage (left for those seated on stage) to greet the graduates as they exit from the stage.
- 18. As each name is announced by Mick Stubbs (and the subsequent name readers) the graduand will process singularly across the stage (from the right to the left (right to left for those seated on stage)) to George Kieffer to receive their certificate. George Kieffer and the graduand will then turn to face the photographer located on stage for one photograph. The student will then exit the stage via the stairs to the left (left for those seated on stage) to be greeted by their Course Leader, before making their way to the back of the Moot Hall to be directed back to their seat.
- 19. Upon the completion of the awards for the School of Visual and Performing Arts Mick Stubbs will invite Neil Barnes to the right lectern (right for those seated on stage) to start the presentation of awards for the School of Social Sciences.
- **20.** On conclusion of the awards Neil Barnes will take his seat and Kevin Prince will invite George Kieffer to deliver his speech from the left lectern (left for those seated on stage).
- 21. Kevin Prince will introduce Alison Andreas who will make a speech from the left lectern (left for those seated on stage).
- **22.** Kevin Prince will bring the ceremony to a close by asking graduates to remain in their gowns and make their way to The Minories Art Gallery for a celebratory reception once the Academic Procession have left the Moot Hall.
- 23. Kevin Prince will close by inviting all to stand whilst the Academic Procession exits led by Mark Cherry, followed Professor Neil James and the front row on stage, followed by the back row on the stage.
